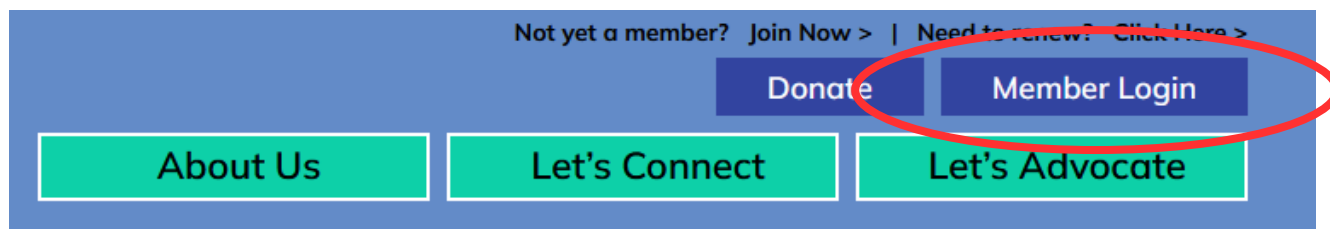

1. Go to: <https://www.aeceo.ca/login>
2. Under "create an account" enter the email address that you used to register as a member
3. Click "send account activation"
4. Check your email inbox for an account activation link (if not in your inbox please check junk/spam/clutter etc)
5. Click on the link and it will bring you back to the website, where you can choose a username and password
6. After choosing your username and password, click, "activate account"

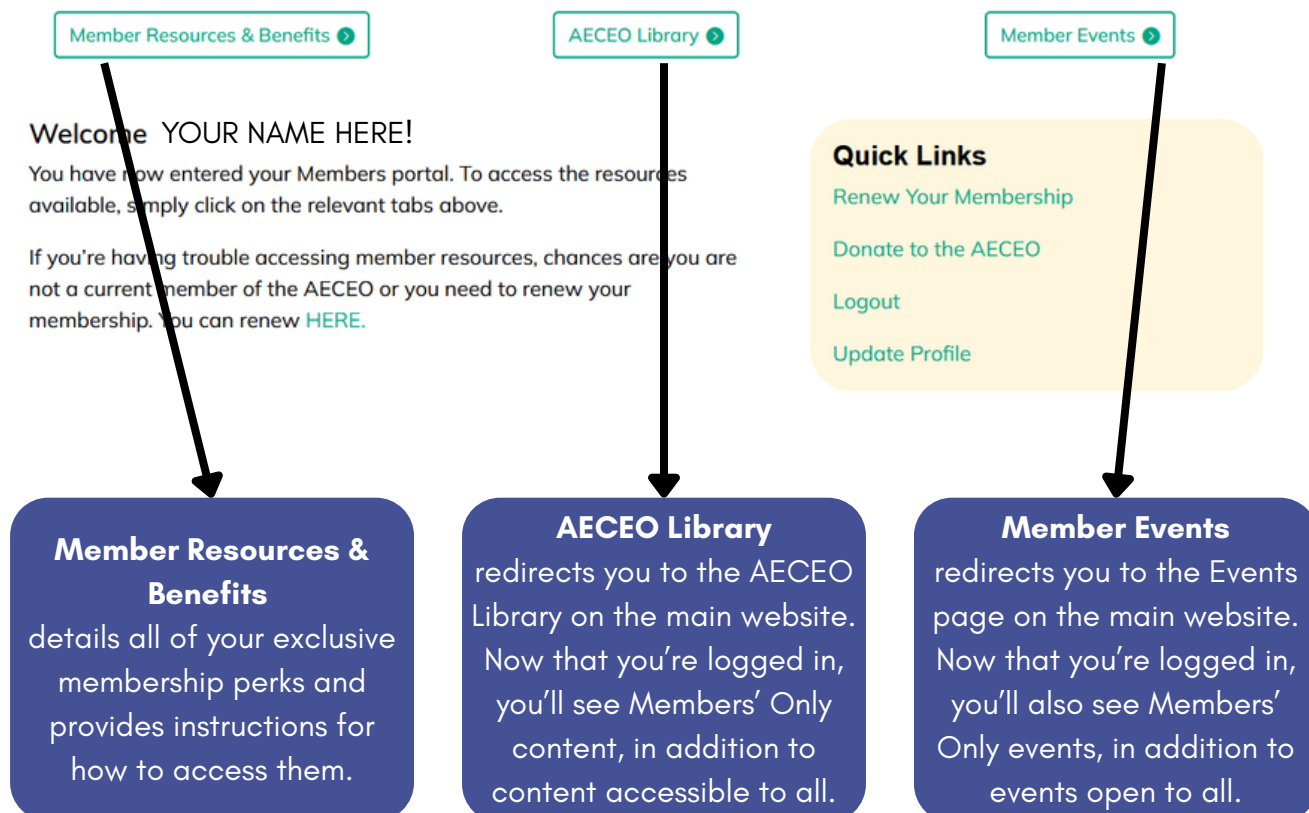

Next, the login in page will open. To log in, type in your login credentials – the email address you registered with and password – in the appropriate fields.

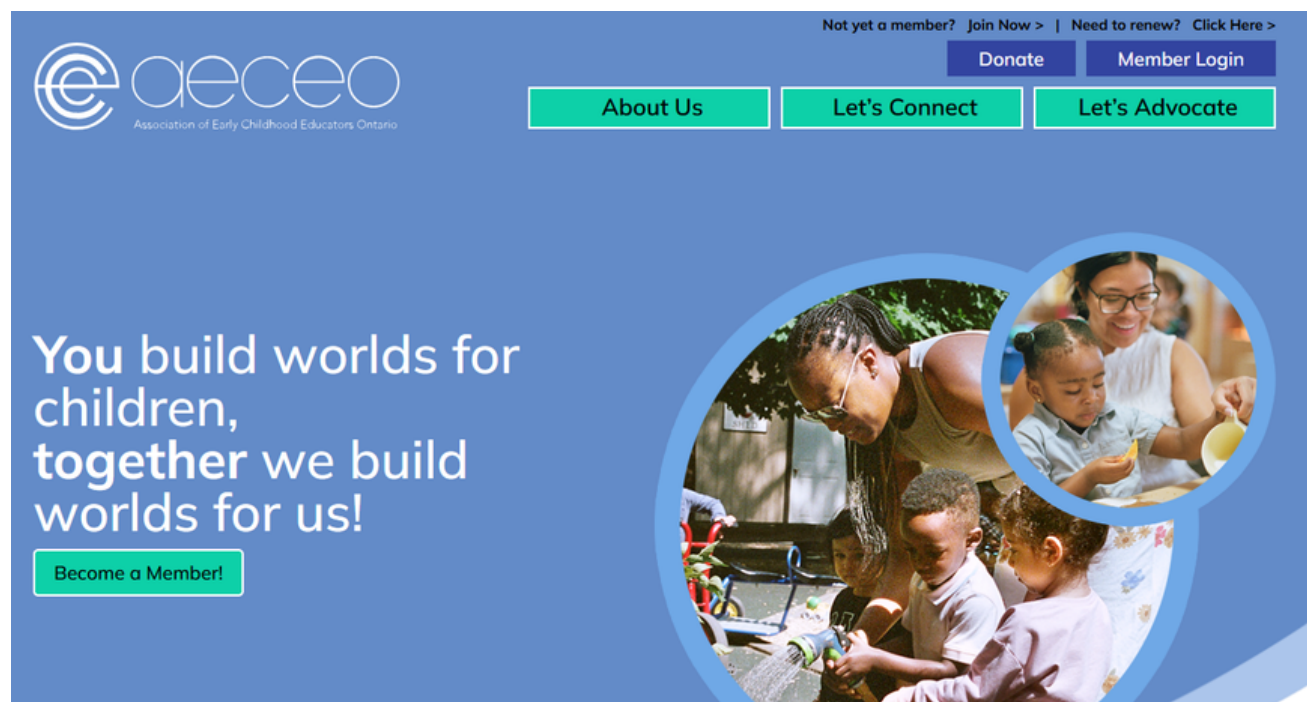
If you are logging in with Google or Microsoft, please ensure you are logged in to the Google or Microsoft account you used to register for your AECEO member account.

Home Page



This is the home page of the new website. The home page contains key pieces of information, including links to become a member of the AECEO and links that redirect you to other sections of the website.

Two items to pay attention to are the "AECEO News" section and the "Events" section, that will be seen as you scroll down.

The News section will provide you with the **three most recent updates** from the AECEO team – this may include important publications, eceLINK updates, policy updates, sharing about upcoming events, and MORE. Clicking on the "More News" button just below the section will show you all of the news updates on the website.

The News section is ONLY found on the home page.

The Events section will list **upcoming events you can register for**. Likewise, clicking the "More Events" will show all events available. *When you are logged in to your Member account, you'll be able to view Members Only events here.*

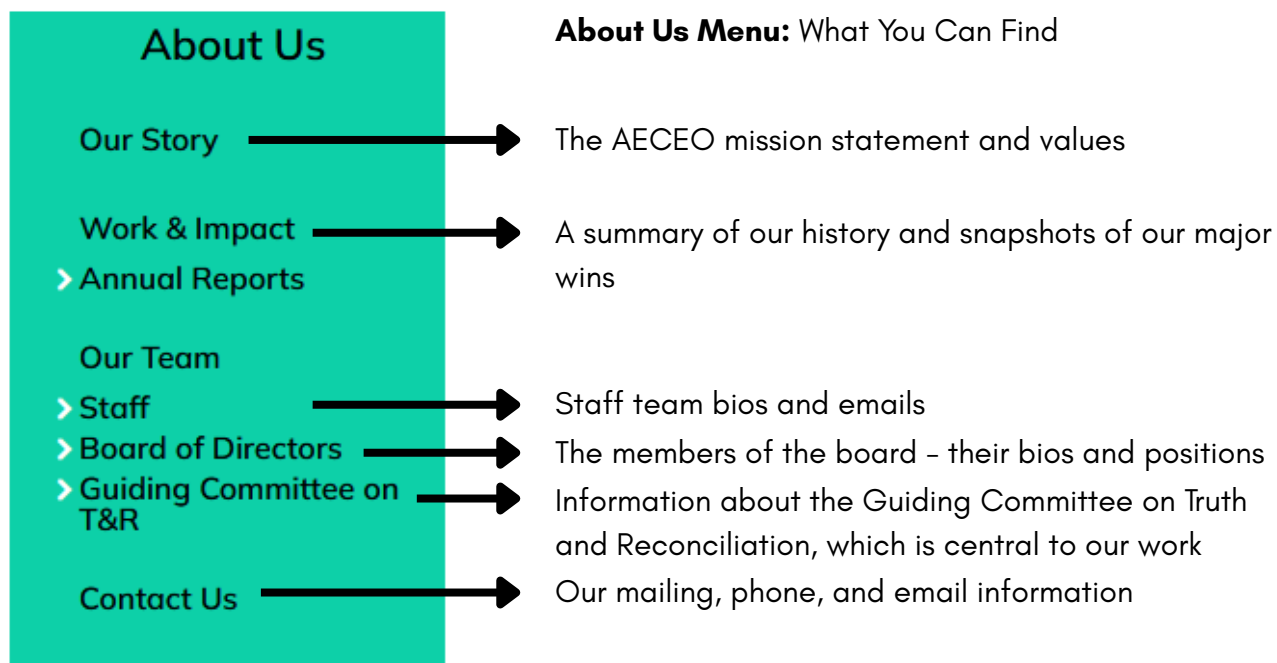
Navigation
